Proceedings conducted at this meeting are being conducted pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan Open Meetings Act and Executive Order 2020-154, and any subsequent amendment, extension, or order allowing flexibility in complying with the Michigan Open Meetings Act issued by Governor Gretchen Whitmer.
