NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a City General Election and a Special Election will be held in several precincts of the Cities and Townships of the County of Genesee, Michigan, on Tuesday, November 07, 2017 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.

The following local proposals will be voted on:

Fenton City – Charter Amendment Proposal, Section 11.1, to allow any voter approved increase in taxes in excess of 13 mills to be for a period not to exceed (10) ten years.

Gaines Township – Fire Department Operations and Building Improvements, millage increase 1.25 mills for (7) seven years.

Gaines Township – Fire Department Capital Equipment Replacements, millage increase .75 mills for a period of (10) ten years.

Flint Community Schools – Proposal to reduce the number of Board members from (9) nine to (7) seven.

Flushing Community Schools – Bond Proposal, for building improvements, in an amount not to exceed \$17,800,000.

Lake Fenton Community Schools – Bond Proposal, for building and site purposes, in an amount not to exceed \$11,755,000.

Linden Community Schools – Sinking Fund Millage Proposal, millage increase 1.3 mills for a period of (10) ten years.

STATEMENT OF COUNTY TREASURER

I, Deborah L. Cherry, Treasurer of Genesee County, Michigan, state that as of September 13, 2017, the records of the Office of Genesee County Treasurer indicate that the total of all voted increases in the total tax rate limitation provided by Section 6 of Article IX of the State Constitution of 1963, and affecting the taxable property in Genesee County, Michigan for property within the **County of Genesee**.

These totals are of the originally voted increases as permanently reduced, however, pursuant to Michigan Compiled Laws Section 211.34(d). The components of the aforementioned totals, stated by governmental units with increased limitations, purposes of the increased limitation, the amount of the limitations in mills and the inclusive years the increases are effective, are as follows:
