

City of Fenton Fun Facts

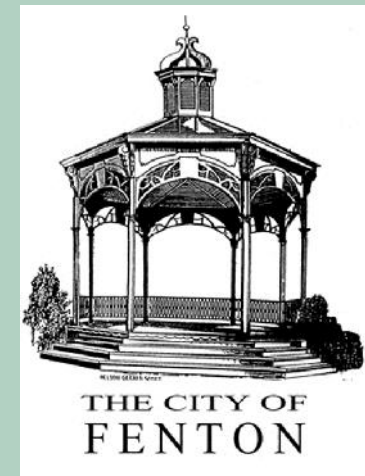
- ⇒ The City obtains drinking water from four municipal drinking water wells located within the city.
- ⇒ The City's drinking water wells are permitted to produce up to 2,620 gallons of groundwater each minute.
- ⇒ The City distributes water through approximately 68.5 miles of water mains.
- ⇒ The City water treatment plant treats 1.125 million gallons of groundwater daily.
- ⇒ There are 602 fire hydrants in the City of Fenton.
- ⇒ The City supplies clean drinking water to approximately 3,600 residential and over 500 commercial and industrial customers.
- ⇒ The City pumped over 348 million gallons through the water plant in 2015.
- ⇒ Michigan has 11,037 inland lakes, no point in Michigan is more than 6 miles from an inland lake, or 85 miles from a Great Lake.
- ⇒ The City distribution system currently contains two groundwater storage reservoirs with a capacity of 1.5 million gallons.

Mission Statement

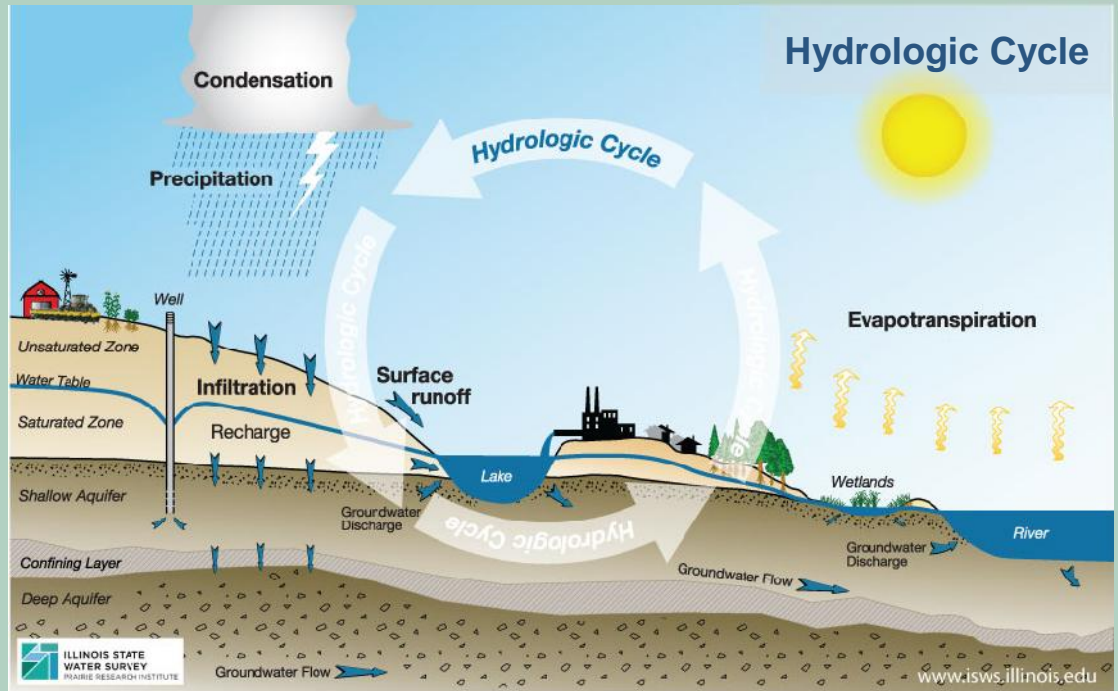
It is the mission of the City of Fenton to control the integrity of the City's water source through public awareness and education to ensure secure, clean, and reliable drinking water for present and future generations.

What is a Wellhead Protection Plan?

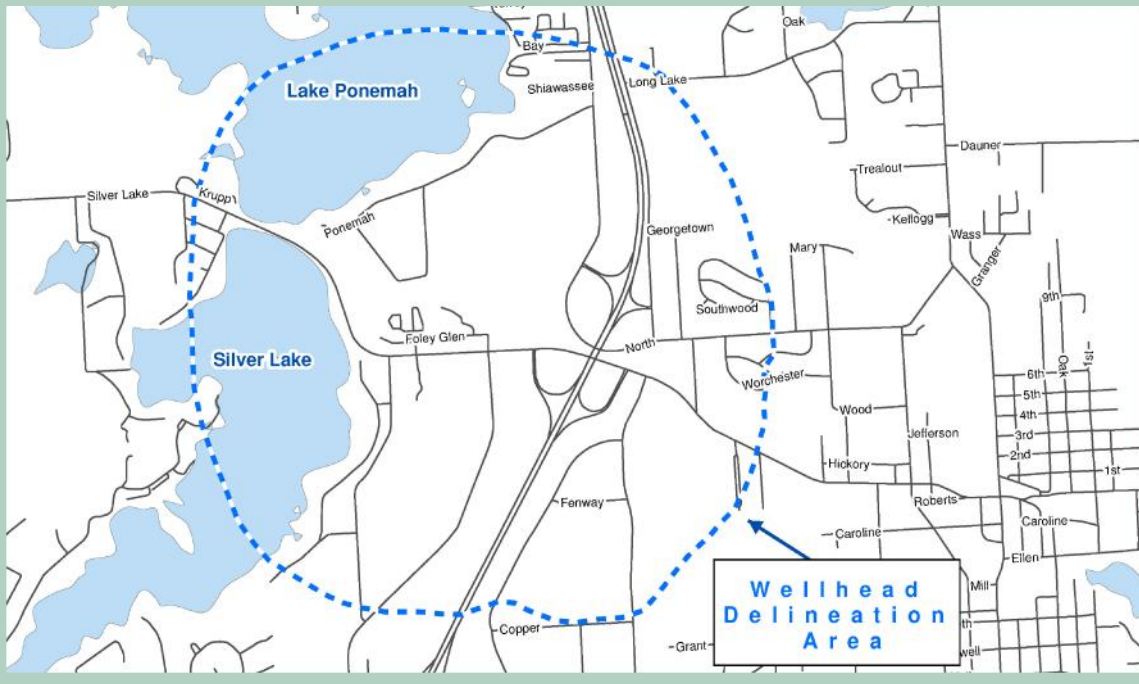
The City of Fenton has implemented this plan and a wellhead protection team that works to protect the City's local drinking water supply from contamination.

Where Does the City of Fenton's Drinking Water Come From?

The City extracts groundwater from four Type 1 groundwater wells located within the City that are the source of the City's municipal water supply.

Why do we need a Wellhead Protection Plan?

The diagram above shows how surface water and contaminants can seep through the surface of the earth and into our groundwater resources. The contaminated water can then flow into a water supply well. Learn about our water sources and spread the information to friends and neighbors.
