FOOD TRUCK ORDINANCE

Hart shared comments and concerns from local business owners. Extended questions discussed:

- Should food trucks be allowed at special events only
- Is a \$500 fee enough for the benefits of moving around the city
- Are restaurants still experiencing post-pandemic hardships
- Should each truck be charged per square foot
- Should the city require a donation to the community
- What will the certification standard be for all

RESIDENTIAL SIDEWALK PROGRAM

A 50/50 program versus a volunteer program was discussed. Affordability for some residents was questioned. This program will be discussed again at the next Council work session.

STREET SIGNAGE

Brisson presented samples and prices of requested street signage options including framed signs with square or round edges, posts with vinyl wrap or powder-coated, and round or square finials. A recommendation will be presented at the next Council meeting.

COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS

Grossmeyer discussed concerns with the Sothern Lakes Parks & Recreation Master Plan with Ed Koledo. Sage was happy to see calendar of events up and shared.

Lockwood reported the Beautification Commission distributed 150 saplings. Planting Day will be June 4th. Friday is the next Freedom Festival meeting.

Markland reported on selling bonds for Water. Attorney reviewing ARPA funds documentation. Soft-launch of new website will be Tuesday.
