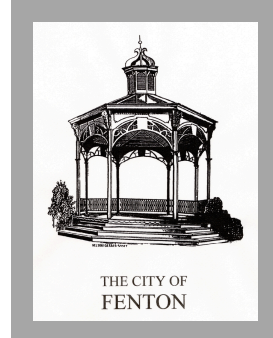

Spring Ordinances

- Rental Inspections are required by ordinance every three years. Contact City Hall to register your rental property.
- Trash receptacles, including solid waste, yard waste, and recyclables can be placed curbside no earlier than 4pm the day before collection. All emptied receptacles must be retrieved and stored by 8pm on the day of collection.
- Grass lawns in the City of Fenton need to be maintained at 6 inches of height or less.
- Starting April 1st, overnight street parking returns for City Residents.

Water Department

- City of Fenton water customers can enroll in paperless and/or ACH billing by visiting <https://gqr.sh/H7NM> and returning the form to City Hall.
- The City of Fenton Water Department will perform water main flushing in Quadrants 1 and 2 (see map on reverse) beginning April 13th through April 18th, 2025. Water main flushing will be performed from 10:00PM through 4:00AM to minimize low water pressure conditions. Learn more and see if you will be effected at <https://gqr.sh/KFw3>
- On November 15th, 2024, letters were mailed to all residents in Fenton that may potentially have galvanized service lines on their property. Homes that have been identified as having a lead/galvanized service line connection are eligible under this program for a new water service line between the water main and the water meter located inside the home at NO cost to the water customer. Disabled Veterans Tax Exemption

Local eligible taxpayers who are also disabled veterans may be able to apply for the State Tax Commission Disabled Veteran Exemption. To qualify, the claimant must be a disabled

veteran or the surviving spouse of a disabled veteran with the property claimed as the homestead of the claimant. 2025 is the last year requiring annual renewal applications.
