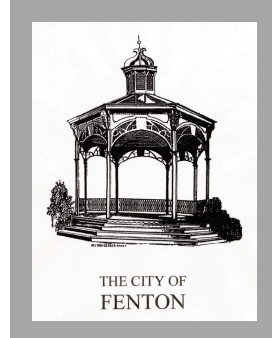

City of Fenton Ongoing Construction Projects

- **Local Roads Project 2025**
 - Equipment will be mobilized and staged on West Elizabeth Street between Park Street and Henry Street. Street reconstruction of West South Holly Road (State Road to Sinclair Street), Sinclair Street, Park Street, West Rockwell, Rockwell (Cliffview condos to Adelaide), Henry Street, Davis Street, and South West Street are included in this phase of the project. Water main will be replaced from West Street, through Cliffview condos, and continuing down Rockwell Street to Adelaide Street. Drainage improvements will be installed throughout the project. Sanitary sewer will be replaced along West Rockwell Street and South West Street. In addition, **West Elizabeth Street from Adelaide Street to Shiawassee Avenue will become one-way westbound with on-street parking at Freedom Park.**
- **Bush Park Pickleball and Tennis Courts**
 - Courts will be ready for use in early July. Once Bush Park Courts are open, the courts in Rackham Park will be removed.
- **Millpond Park and Riverwalk**
 - Millpond Park Gazebo Plaza Project Phase One will begin after the July 4th holiday in 2025. Phase One of this project includes Riverwalk upgrades from Millpond Park to Rackham Park, additional footage of Riverwalk that connects to Rackham Park by crossing Caroline Street and extending along the Shiawassee River to the east of Huntington Bank, ending at Silver Lake Road, with boardwalk and a pocket park, replacement of the bridge that crosses over the Millpond Dam, canoe launches and lockers at Millpond Park, new playground equipment, and exercise stations on Riverwalk.

The following is required of those seeking consideration on the November 4, 2025 General Election ballot:

- Must be 18 years old and registered voter in the City for at least one year immediately prior to the last day for filing original petitions.
- Submit a completed, notarized, Affidavit of Identity.
- Submit nominating petitions signed by not less than 50, and no more than 100 registered electors of the City. Because some signatures can be rendered invalid, it is recommended to get more than the minimum number of signatures required to avoid complications.

It is recommended to read the back of both the Affidavit of Identity and Nominating Petition forms for instructions on how to properly complete both forms. An incomplete/incorrect petition sheet can cause the signatures on that sheet to be deemed invalid and will not count toward the number of signatures needed to be placed on the ballot.

Please submit completed information to the City Clerk's office by the date and time as indicated above.

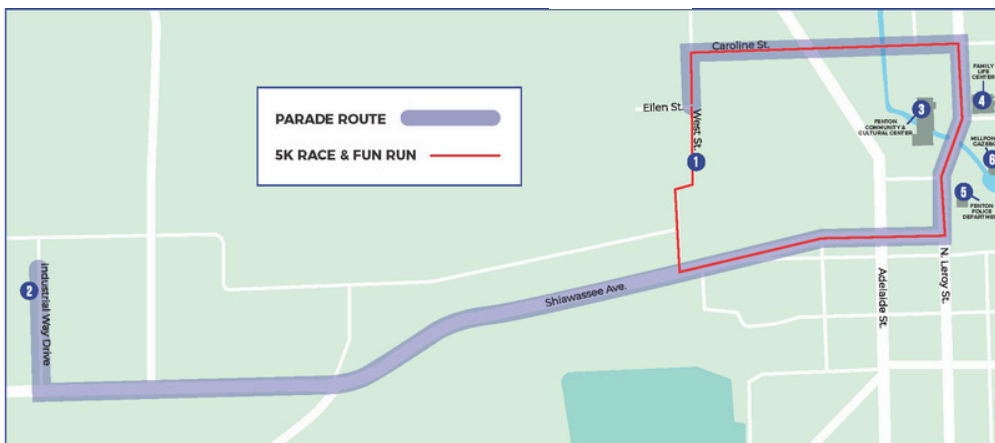
Assessor's Office

Building and Zoning Department

- **Rental Inspections** are required by ordinance every three years. Contact City Hall to register your rental property.
- **Trash receptacles**, including solid waste, yard waste, and recyclables can be placed curbside no earlier than 4pm the day before collection. All emptied receptacles must be retrieved and stored by 8pm on the day of collection.
- **Grass lawns** in the City of Fenton need to be maintained at 6 inches of height or less.
